



## **PFLAG NAPA 2018 Scholarship Application**

Parents, Families and Friends of Lesbians and Gays, Napa Chapter is a non-profit charitable organization whose MISSION STATEMENT is to promote the health and well being of gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender and intersex (LGBTQ) persons, their families and friends through support, education, and advocacy to end discrimination and to secure civil rights.

PFLAG Napa invites all students, who have demonstrated outstanding support for the LGBT community at their school or in the community at large, to apply for a scholarship funded through the Rykken/Scull LGBT Memorial Fund.

Students are eligible to apply if they are a high school seniors anticipating graduation in 2018 and are planning to enroll in a university or college, technical school, performing arts school or art college. Persons who have graduated prior to 2018 or students currently attending one of the above-mentioned institutions are also encouraged to apply.

**Applicants must be residents of Napa, Sonoma, Mendicino, or Marin Counties.** Awards will made to selected individuals.

- To recognize outstanding persons from our communities for their involvement in the LGBTQ community.
- To encourage post-secondary education of LGBTQ persons and their allies.
- To promote a positive image of LGBTQ persons in society.
